


# GLOBAL RESULTS FRAMEWORK

## Local Context 2020

### Fostering Childhood Success



#### LOCAL CONTEXT

- 29% of Forward Wayne County survey respondents with children under 5 have not been able to find "safe, affordable, quality childcare." <sup>1</sup>
- Only 21% of children in Wayne County (31% in Union) in need of care are enrolled in "high quality childcare" <sup>2</sup>
- Wayne County is ranked 3rd in number of children living in single-parent homes <sup>3</sup>
- The 2020-2022 Reid Health Implementation Plan established a goal to "Improve the health of the community by preventing Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) and reducing the impact of ACEs" <sup>4</sup>

### Encouraging Youth Success



#### LOCAL CONTEXT

- Wayne County rankings (out of 92 counties) for the following educational assessments of 3rd-8th graders:
  - IREAD-3: 66th
  - English/Language Arts ISTEP: 79th
  - Math ISTEP: 91st <sup>3</sup>
- Wayne County's high school graduation rate was 83.4% in 2020. <sup>3</sup>
- Wayne County is ranked 10th in the state for the number of children (ages 0-17) living in poverty. <sup>3</sup>

### Building Economic Mobility



#### LOCAL CONTEXT

- Forward Wayne County Survey respondents highlighted the desire for a stronger local economy and the need for more jobs to incentivize people to stay in the community. <sup>1</sup>
- For women 25-54 years old, the most common reason for not working in 2018 was in-home responsibilities – caring for children, or for an aging parent or family member with a disability or chronic health issue. <sup>5</sup>
- Lack of access to internet at home impacts the ease of applying for jobs, accessing financial services and apps, and access to education. <sup>5</sup>

### Increasing Access to Health



#### LOCAL CONTEXT

- 11.9% Of Wayne county residents do not have health insurance. <sup>7</sup>
- 12.9% Of Wayne county residents have received Food Stamps or SNAP in the last 12 months. <sup>7</sup>
- Wayne county ranks 87th out of 92 Indiana counties in 'Health Outcomes'. <sup>7</sup>
- The 2020-2022 Reid Health Implementation Plan Identified 3 main goals:
  1. Promote mental, emotional, and behavioral well-being within the communities we serve by improving mental health and reducing substance misuse.
  2. Improve the health of the community by encouraging healthy choices and reducing the disparities related to activity and nutrition.
  3. Improve the health of the community by preventing Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) and reducing the impact of ACEs. <sup>4</sup>
